## Ballet Hispánico at Moody Performance Hall

**L**atino culture infuses the work of Ballet Hispánico, an almost half-century-old dance company based in New York City. Presented by TITAS, the company's Dallas performance features work by three female choreographers, including Houston-born Michelle Manzanales. In *Con Brazos Abiertos (With Open Arms)*, Manzanales explores the iconic Mexican symbols she was reluctant to embrace as a Mexican-American child. Other works include Annabelle Lopez Ochoa's *Linea Recta (Straight Line)*, a deconstruction of flamenco, and Tania Perez-Salas' theatrical *Catorce Dieciseis (Fourteen Sixteen)*, drawing inspiration from the number pi.
