

In-Person Classes: Steps to Return

The School of Dance looks forward to welcoming students back to in-person classes Monday, January 31, 2022. Please see the steps below to ensure a smooth return to the building:

1. Key to NYC Update

In accordance with the Key to NYC mandate, **students ages 5 and older** (including Pasitos 2 caregivers attending class) must submit proof of FULL vaccination to enter the BH building for in-person classes. Submit proof of vaccination [here](#).

A student is considered fully vaccinated immediately after they have received a second dose in a two-dose vaccine series or a single-dose vaccine.

2. Daily Health Questionnaire

Beginning January 10, 2022, all students entering the BH building are required to fill out the [SOD Daily Health Questionnaire](#) in advance, every day they attend class. Students will not be admitted into the building until the questionnaire has been completed.

TIP: Bookmark the Daily Health Questionnaire on your phone and/or computer for easy access in your daily routine.

3. Recommended Masks

It is highly recommended that students wear an N95 or KN95 mask as they provide the highest level of protection according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Fitted surgical masks are the next best option. Parents and guardians are asked to review the proper way to wear a mask with their students.
